I understand **ALL** horses present at this sale shall meet the following requirements:

- EIA/Coggins: An original copy of a negative test within 12 months on all equine more than 6 months of age. Foals less than six (6) months of age must be accompanied by their negative tested dam or have their own test.
- All horses assigned from out of state must have a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection signed by an accredited veterinarian, in addition to a negative EIA test.

Sale management agrees to verify that:

- Horses from out of state have a properly completed CVI
- Have complete records of both seller's and buyer's full name, address, and phone number, and description of equine sold (name/ID number, breed, sex, color, brands/markings)

Sale management agrees to send the above information to Animal Industry Services within 15 days of the sale or maintain all records in an easily retrievable location for a minimum of five (5) years. Records maintained by sale managers must be made available to ODAFF when requested.
